Time

Sevilla SVQ Airport - City Centre

The city center around 20 km from the airport, around 20 minutes by car (in case of traffic the taxi driver could choose different routes).

To arrive from the airport using public transport, there is a specific BUS line called **EA** ("Especial Aeropuerto") that connects the airport with the city, there are two stops close to the city center and venue: Avenida Carlos V (Prado San Sebastián) and Paseo Cristóbal Colón (Torre del Oro).

SPECIAL AIRPORT BUS LINE

The **EA Line** (Especial Aeropuerto) service operates daily at the following times:

o To Seville: 05:20 a.m. - 01:15 a.m.

o To the airport: 04:30 a.m. - 12:30 a.m.

→Frequency: Every 25-30 minutes

→ Journey duration: Approximately 35 minutes

TAXI

Another option is to take a taxi from the airport to the center of Seville. The journey takes between 15 and 20 minutes.

o Fixed fare: €26

Nighttime, weekends, and public holidays fare: Approximately €28

Monuments and cultural activities - Our recommendations

Among all the historic buildings that Seville treasures constructions stand out that you cannot miss. A set that was declared by the UNESCO World Heritage Site: the Cathedral with the Giralda, the Archivo de Indias, the Real Alcázar and Plaza de España

- → Cathedral of Seville is the largest Gothic cathedral in the world and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Built on the site of a former mosque, it houses the tomb of Christopher Columbus and features the iconic Giralda bell tower.
- →Torre del Oro construction dates back to the thirteenth century, when it formed part of the Almohad defense system. Inside is the Naval Museum, which houses important documentation on the nautical history of Seville.
- → Plaza de España an emblematic monument of the city, designed by the architect Aníbal González. It was the headquarters of the Latin American Exhibition of 1929. Really a must of Seville together with Maria Luisa Park, that counts with an area of 340,000 m2.
- → **Setas de Sevilla** a bold modern structure towers over the Plaza de la Encarnación, officially known as Metropol Parasol.
- → Archivo de Indias is a UNESCO World Heritage Site that preserves invaluable documents related to the Spanish colonies in the Americas. Housed in a Renaissance building next to the cathedral, it offers a glimpse into the history of the Spanish Empire.
